48 test cars have arrived

Heavy trucks have been coming to Tannisby Thursday and Friday and unloaded their valuable load of test cars. One Fiat 600e and the Lucid Air are expected Monday.

As a sign of the changing times, for the first time in decades there is no diesel cars this year, even though a few of them will be available with a diesel option.



Furthermore, just two cars, the Broncos, are pure petrol, while another four are HEV and nine are PHEV. The remaining 34 are EV, so pure electrics make up 69% of the test cars. Last year it was 45%.



Four Renault Scenics are at Tannistest. Two of them – both in camouflage are available for test drives. One is without camouflage but only for static demonstration in the tent behind the main building. The fourth is for the service team. Keys are available at the keyboard.

Enjoy the beach

In this corner of Europe, it is allowed to drive on the beach – 300 meters from Tannishus. So, enjoy the spectacular drive here.

Remember to be careful and considerable, especially to pedestrians. The (recommended) speed limit is 30 km/h.

Also, the sand is tricky. Be aware of this when you drive and park, especially in a 2WD. It is possible to drive 0.4 km to the left and 1.5 km to the right, before you meet small streams.
