On behalf of the Nordic Jury Group, I am very happy to welcome both Jurors and representatives of the car industry to the 43th Car of the Year test event at Tannishus – also known as the traditionally Tannistest.

It has been a crazy time, since we had the previous test in 2019 – 2020 was cancelled for the first time ever – you know the reason...

This year we have done our best to bring the test back on track. And we have struggled to organize as many candidate cars as possible to be part of the Tannistest 2021, so we can start the journey towards Car of the Year 2022.

The list of candidates is not yet confirmed. However, we can already quite well recognize the tentative COTY candidates. This year we have 28 of the possible candidates represented. The

total number of test cars is at an almost record: 67 cars!
